



ARC TREE REMOVAL GUIDELINES

No trees shall be removed from any CR property without the express consent of the ARC except for:

- Diseased or dead trees.
- Trees that need removing to promote the healthy growth of other trees.
- Trees that need removing for safety reasons.
- Trees within ten (10) feet of perimeter of an existing building, driveway, walkway, or pool deck.
- Trees that create a safety hazard.
- Trees that are at risk of falling on a house.

Cherokee Ridge recommends routine pruning of all trees to encourage the development of stronger and healthier trees:

- On young trees, protect the leader, or main trunk, from competition.
- Remove diseased or insect-infested wood.
- When branches rub or cross each other, remove one.
- Remove branches that could fall and cause injury or property damage.
- Remove suckers or side shoots from the base of the tree using a knife or scissors.
- Prune lower limbs to expose more trunk.
- Lightly prune upper limbs to enhance the natural shape.

TREE REMOVAL FROM GOLF COURSE ADJACENT LOTS

Owners of a Golf Course Lot shall not undertake any landscaping program or remove any trees of a diameter of 4" or more from the portion of their Lot within thirty-five (35) feet of the Golf Course without the prior written approval of the ARC.
